Staff Dress Code (all non-faculty)

The School dress code exists so that staff may express their creative flair and also appear professionally dressed.

Appropriate:

Good hygiene

Clean Clothing

Clothing that covers the shoulder continuously over the torso to 6 inches above the knee or below
Bras

Safe Shoes

Sleeveless tops should have straps that are at least 2 inches wide and cover the underarm

Necklines that do not reveal cleavage

Strapless, spaghetti straps, off the shoulder, and camisoles are acceptable when worn with a
jacket, sweater or shirt that covers the shoulders and is not removed during working hours

Inappropriate:

Poor hygiene

Dirty Clothing

Torn, ripped or clothing with holes

Clothing that reveals underwear

Halters, tube tops, or muscle shirts

Strapless, spaghetti straps, off the shoulder, and camisoles without a jacket, sweater, or shirt to
cover the shoulders

Low necklines, cleavage, midriff, underarm, back or below the waist exposure

Clothing with offensive statements or pictures

Skirts or shorts more than 6 inches above the knee

Dangerous jewelry

Dangerous footwear

Pajamas
